

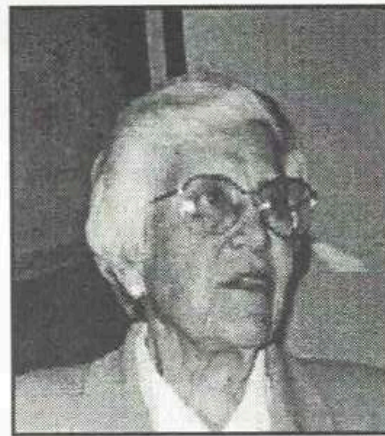
## Tribute Luncheon Honors Dorothy Rosenwald For 60 Plus Years of Commitment to NCJW
